

EVALUATION

Your project evaluation must include evidence that you have considered the following:

1. Your initial ideas and starting points.

How did your ideas develop from what you originally thought that you would do?
What is your research and where did you collect it from?
What plans did you make about how you tackle this project?
What was the basis of your idea for this project?

2. What are the successful elements and strengths of your project?

Consider the project as a whole, what are you most pleased with and why? What went well for you?
What techniques did you decide to use and why?
Where did you get your source materials and why were these chosen?

3. What are the weaker elements or failures of your project?

What aspect of the project are you least pleased with and why?
What did not go so well? What are you most unhappy with? How do you intend to address these weaknesses and improve in future projects?

4. Did you have any difficulties?

What problems arose throughout your project development, and how did you overcome these?
What changes did you make to the original idea as you developed your design and why?

5. Have there been any restrictions or constraints that have affected your work?

Consider time available and your time management, availability of equipment, budget, and materials available, etc.

6. Explain the decisions that you have made throughout the project.

Why did you decide to do things the way that you did?
What influenced you or helped you to make your decisions?
What feedback did you receive from your peers/tutor?
What do you consider are the strengths of your final design?
What do you consider are the weaknesses of your final design?

7. Is your final outcome suitable for the intended purpose you originally identified in your brief?

Consider the fabric, materials, techniques and processes used, the scale and colour of the design. Is it a suitable outcome?
What have you discovered/learnt from your project?

8. Given the opportunity to do the project again what would you do differently this time, and why?

9. What do you think about the quality of the work that you have produced and how you have managed your time?

Are you pleased with your final outcome/ the way that your work has developed?

10. What have you learnt from this experience?
